Hebrews 11:1 says, *“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.”* Let’s look at this verse in the amplified Bible so we can gain a better understanding of it:

*“Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].”*

When we grasp this and when it settles into our spirits, we will begin to see the results that God intended for us to see. **Our faith, spoken through our words, serves as the title deed for things that we do not yet see in the natural.** Just like in the natural, you possess the title deed to your home and car (if you own them). You have the proof that they belong to you because your name is listed on the title deed. The only real evidence you have of owning your home and your car is that little piece of paper that has YOUR name and YOUR information on it as the owner of those things. Now let’s go back and look at what the Bible calls faith in Hebrews, **“Now FAITH is the assurance (the confirmation, the TITLE DEED) of the things we hope for, being the PROOF of things we do not see...”** Our faith is to serve as our title deed or evidence of things we do not yet see in the natural. In fact, in the above verse from Hebrews the amplified Bible says this also, “Faith perceiving as real fact what is NOT revealed to the senses.”

Just because our results haven’t yet manifested (displayed or become apparent) in the natural realm does NOT mean that they haven’t come into existence yet. There are two realms that we are dealing with here: the natural or the “seen” realm and supernatural “unseen” to the human eye realm. When we speak something into existence in the natural realm, we must believe that it will come to pass. **It has already taken form in the supernatural realm.** We may not see the manifestation in the natural realm right away but that doesn’t mean our faith isn’t working. We have to put our faith to work through our words! Words are serious business. And, as believers, we need to get serious about learning how to use them. We need to begin to put them to work for us like God Himself does. Remember, we have been given the same privilege of using words as God Himself (Prov. 18:21). The Bible tells us that He uses words to *“call those things which be not as though they were”* (Romans 4:17).

How do we do that? We speak by FAITH what we want our end result to be. Do you need healing in your body? Speak healing scriptures over yourself DAILY. Do you need a financial breakthrough? Find the appropriate scriptures on finances (Proverbs has a lot of verses on this) and speak them over your situation DAILY. Do you need restoration in your marriage or family? Dig in the word and find the key verses that deal with restoration or forgiveness if that’s the case. You’ll be amazed at how the Holy Spirit will take you directly to the right verse for your particular situation! **If you are consistent AND faithful to speak the Word in faith, you will see results.** The Bible tells us that His Word (the Word of God) will never return void (Isaiah 55:11)! That’s a promise! “You mean I’m supposed to say, ‘I’m healed’ when I’m feeling sick? I’m supposed to say, ‘I’m prosperous’ when I’m penniless? That sounds like lying to me.”

No, no. There’s a BIG difference between lying and speaking by faith. A lie is meant to deceive someone. It’s designed to make someone believe something that’s not true. **But to speak by faith is simply to speak words that agree with the Word of God instead of the circumstances around you.** It’s speaking from your spirit instead of from your mind.

Apostle Paul said in 2 Corinthians 4:13, "We have the same spirit of faith as he had who wrote, I have believed, and therefore have I spoken. We too believe, and therefore we speak" (*The Amplified Bible*). Read that verse again. "I have believed, and therefore have I spoken." Some people speak words but don't have the faith to back it up, and as a result, they become discouraged because their situation isn't improving. We don't "call things that are not as we *wished* they were"; we "call things that are not as **though** they were." Wishing and hoping will not get you results. **You have to believe you receive and wait with expectation** (Mark 11:24). God will come through for you!

But what do we do if our results don't come as quickly as we want them to? What do we say to people who ask about our situation and we still haven't received our breakthrough yet? We remain steadfast and unmovable on the Word of God and refuse to accept what we see with our natural eyes (1 Corinthians 15:58). We continue to speak God's Word over the situation until it produces the results we are **expecting**. Sometimes it's best not say too much to people during this period and seek the Lord instead. There will be people around you who will not understand the process and they may cause you to be disappointed or stumble. This may be a time of testing in your life as you wait patiently through faith for your results. But don't get discouraged!

Many people start strong. They begin to declare the word of God daily, they stand on the promises of God everyday and little by little they become discouraged because "it's not working." That's simply not true. Don't ever say "it's not working" out of your mouth. **By saying words that disagree with the word of God, you are cancelling out all of the work you have been doing so far.** And unfortunately, the enemy can barely wait to get you to that point. But if you continue steadfast and hold on to the promises you've been declaring, you will see your breakthrough! Remember- **your faith serves as your title deed to that miracle!** You own that miracle, it's yours and it's on the way!

We hope you have been inspired and encouraged by this powerful teaching. We suggest that you read this newsletter a few times over until the word begins to stir inside of your spirit man. If you are faced with a difficult situation, begin digging in the word of God. Use Google to search out scriptures for your particular situation and stand on those promises DAILY. It's important to stay focused and make your declarations out loud every single day. We suggest writing them down or making a vision board of all that you are believing God for. If you need further help, you can call our prayer line. We would love to pray in agreement with you according to Matthew 18:19, ***"Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven."***
