## Happy Thanksgiving friends and partners!

You are so loved by us! We cover you with our prayers daily! As we prepare to celebrate one of the biggest holidays of the year, we are reminded of what it really means to be thankful in everything. This doesn't mean your life is perfect or that you don't have any problems. We're all facing something. We want to remain thankful in everything because 1 Thessalonians tells us that is the will of God. Why would the word of God tell us to be thankful in everything when "everything" isn't going right? Because being thankful puts our heart in the position to recognize God in the midst of difficulties.

Psalm 50:14 says, Make thankfulness your sacrifice to God.

Psalms 50:23 says, But giving thanks is a sacrifice that truly honors me. If you keep to my path, I will reveal to you the salvation of God.

The truth is that whether we feel like it or not, God deserves our thankfulness and praise every single day. He is worthy of it because He adopted us into His own family and calls us His beloved children. He sent His own precious Son to die on a cross, scourged and beaten beyond recognition- for us. It's not a matter of feeling; it's a matter of the heart. Giving thanks, when done in honesty and humility, changes our heart. Thanksgiving shouldn't only be done when we feel like it. The Bible doesn't tell us to give thanks on the days when we feel like it. We're to do it every day, no matter what the circumstance may be. Your thanks to God today may sound like this, God I thank you for getting me through this divorce. I thank you that I have your peace every day and that satan can't steal it from me! Your thanksgiving may even be, Lord I thank you for that new job. I don't have it yet but in Jesus name, through faith, I take it. It's mine! You can be thankful for the things you don't possess in the natural yet! If you believe you receive them, you have them in Jesus name (Mark 11:24).

Thanksgiving changes our perspective. It keeps us humble, softhearted, obedient, and open to receive what God has for us next. It even builds our spirit man up and reminds us of who we are in Christ. I am thankful that I have the mind of Christ (1 Cor 2:16)

I am thankful that You have good plans for me, You want to prosper me and give me a future! (Jer 29:11)

I am thankful that You fight for me and I only have to be still (Ex 14:14)

I am thankful that you give me strength and increase my power (Isaiah 40:29,31)
