A heat wave is uncomfortable in the natural and everyone can relate to being hot and uncomfortable. Most of us run to the air conditioning to cool off or under some sort of shade to escape the sweltering temperatures of summer, but are we guilty of doing the same thing with our faith? Do we let our faith "cool down" because things get tough or uncomfortable in our lives?

Just like the heat thermometer is high outdoors, our faith thermometer should be too. The enemy and his attacks should not be able to withstand the faith wave that's reflecting off of us! When that doctor's diagnosis comes in, our faith wave can stand against it. When the enemy says our marriage is failing, our faith wave is hot and ready for action. When your prodigal son or daughter seems like they're further away from God, our faith wave springs into action and declares the Word over them. Why? Because we've been training our faith and growing it by being in the Word of God daily (Romans 10:17) and meditating on It. Our faith is red hot and ready to combat all the fiery darts of the enemy!

This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Joshua 1:8

In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Ephesians 6:16

When the tough times come, and they will come (John 16:33), our faith *needs* to be red hot. It's time to shift our focus off of the problem and focus on our battle strategy and spiritual weapons. Our gas tank should be full of the "Word" to the brim. Our thought life should be filled up to the brim with the Word because the Word of God is alive and active! Our mouth should be over filled with flaming faith words to withstand and extinguish all the wiles of the enemy (Ephesians 6:11)! Our faith should be as alive and active as the Word of God is!

We encourage you to continue spending time in the Word of God *daily* and meditating on that Word throughout your day. It's never a matter of quantity but rather *quality time* in the Word and in prayer. Sometimes it's easy to get carried away with so much outside information getting thrown at us every time we turn on our TV's or open our phones. Information overload can put our minds in a whirlwind which can bring confusion. If we aren't careful, we can begin to doubt God and His Word. Make a quality decision and an achievable goal today to put the Word of God first before anything else (Matthew 6:33). Even if it's a verse or two per day. You can spend all day meditating and "chewing" on this Word until it gets deep down in your heart. Another important way to keep our faith wave strong, is to stay connected and surrounded with like minded Christians and mentors who will encourage us in our faith walk, hold us accountable and are a God-centered anchor in our lives. This, along with the Word of God and prayer will keep our faith wave as persistent and red hot as the heat wave we're all feeling right now!
